SKIES ARE BROKEN, VISIBILITY 10 MILES. THE SHIP IS COMING TO STATION ON PRINCETON'S ST'BD QUARTER. STEERING VARIOUS COURSES AND MAKING 20 KTS WHILE TAKING STATION. 0129 9/16 TO 330° - BASE COURSE 9/16 TO 15 KTS BASE SPEED.
